

Will My Computer Run SuperFox?



To run SuperFox your computer needs to use one of these Microsoft operating systems:

- Windows XP
- Windows Vista
- Windows 7
- Windows 8

We recently discontinued support for Windows 2000, but this was only because the operating system is no longer supported by Microsoft.

Disk Space and Memory

SuperFox has been written to use only small amounts of your computer's resources so that it will work on both old and new PCs.

- You will need about 160Mb of free hard disk space for the installation.
- SuperFox uses about 80Mb of physical memory when generating the larger reports.

Screen Size

Your computer will need to have a minimum screen size of 1024 x 768 pixels to use some of the larger forms in SuperFox.

If you have set your display settings to use the large size DPI setting of 120dpi rather than the normal 96 DPI, then you will need a minimum screen size of 1280 x 960 pixels instead.

If you intend to use SuperFox on a Netbook or a similar device with a small screen please take care to check the screen size of your machine first.



These are modest requirements and most new or old computers commonly in use today should be capable of running SuperFox.
